Key Issues Raised

Given that both projects involve the usage of a mobile app (and website) to report environmental crime cases, LIFE NATURA THEMIS representatives discussed with LIFE PROWhIBIT representatives a series of issues that they have faced and should be taken into consideration by LIFE PROWhIBIT, such as:

- Clearing out of cases received through the mobile app proved to be a daunting task (LIFE NATURA THEMIS has been receiving non-relevant cases).
- They faced difficulties with the classification of environmental crime cases and assignment of their handling to the right authorities, based on how serious each case was.
- Authorities' response time was not satisfactory.
- LIFE NATURA THEMIS is facing difficulties in resolving the after-LIFE maintenance of their mobile app, so as to keep it operating after the project's completion.

Key Actions Decided

- Collaboration on communications and dissemination activities.
- Exploration of whether LIFE NATURA THEMIS' mobile app can be utilized by the LIFE PROWhIBIT project, as a transition stage until the nation-wide mobile app of LIFE PROWhIBIT is ready.
- Communication between the Lawyers' Associations in Crete that partnered with LIFE NATURA
 THEMIS project and the Project Coordinator of LIFE PROWhIBIT, in order to explore the
 process of obtaining data on related criminal cases.
- Signing of an MoU on the collaboration of the two projects.
